


**ACTIVITY REPORT OF KALPATHARU PLANTATION PROGRAMME**

As a part of KALPATHARU Plantation program, a part of BCDE activities, our college has conducted a massive plantation program in one of our adopted villages KOPPARTHI, near our college and also in our college campus in two spells on 16<sup>th</sup> November and on 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> November.

This unique approach of "plantation & sustenance" has significant benefits such as deep awareness about the environment, behavioural changes & caring towards the environment, that goes beyond plantations.

By direction from APSICHE, to meet the target of 50% green cover by 2029 BCDE, initiated KalpTaruh Mass Plantation and Sustenance Project on 21st December, 2022. Accordingly, **by the direction from University Officials**, it is informed that the attached list of colleges are identified under JNT University Anantapur for mass plantation from 1st November, 2022 and data is shared with Secretary & CEO, BCDE, Govt of Andhra Pradesh. ### **Introduction:**

**KalpTaruh** is KalpTaru + Ruh – This term is a confluence of 2 objectives, Taru Means Tree in Hindi and Ruh means the Spiritual Energy/Being/Spirit that functions through the body.

Trees symbolize many spiritual values, for example, the Banyan tree is known to be a symbol of abundance, whereas the Peepal tree is known to be a symbol of respect & sacredness. Similarly, inherent to every soul is a spectrum of virtues, which if brought into practice makes life- blissful, relationships- harmonious, teams- effective, society- just, environment- clean and healthy, and the world- perfect and glorious. With this project, we aim to combine the sacred process to nurture a tree as well as the soul through values, as the project is to provide sustenance to both the plant and the person who plants. So, the word has been clubbed together to form – **Kalp Taruh**.

Sanskriti School of Business has taken up this initiative and Students of Sanskriti School of Business have actively participated in the mass plantation programme and planted trees in the Beedupalli road. Initially, the BCDE coordinator - Dr. K Aparna, Sister V. K. Veena, Head of EEE dept Prof. M. Venkateswara Rao, Vice Principal C. Subhas and the chief guest, principal of JNTUA College of Engineering Kalikiri, Prof. S.V. Sathyanarayana are honorably invited onto the dias.

Later, the BCDE coordinator addressed the gathering about deforestation, various reasons of global warming and pollution. She gave the ratio of trees to humans and explained the importance of forests. She gave a brief lesson on how trees teach us to lead our lives, not to depend on anyone, to stay grounded even at the highest and how to stand through thick and thin. She expressed her gratitude to the guests of the event for accepting the request of being part in massive plantation which is organized wonderfully and she also extended her sincere thanks to Brahmakumaris team.

Principal Prof. S.V Satyanarayana appreciated the BCDE team for taking steps for planting trees of best species beside the Administration block. He advised the students to take care of their survival and growth, so that by the time they complete the course, the plants shall become in to grown up trees. The plants will give fruits for healthier living of human being and gives abundant oxygen, which is very essential for survival of man on the earth, He motivated and quoted, even if own children fail to look after the parents, plants gives great support for livelihood of people. During the program students demonstrated

need of the plantation and displayed placards messages like, 'EACH ONE PLANT ONE', 'TREES ON GLOBAL WARMING OFF'.

Principal Prof. S.V Satyanarayana appreciated the BCDE team for taking steps for planting trees of best species beside the Administration block. Vice-Principal, Prof. C. Subhas said that, Trees control climate by moderating the effects of sun, rain and wind. They also lower the air temperature and reduce the heat intensity of the greenhouse effect by maintaining low levels of carbon dioxide.





Sister V. K.Veena excellently explained the life of a tree. It starts with a small seed buried under the ground and with time it grows up extending its roots and branches just to provide shelter to other living beings. Just as this, a human should grow up to be responsible towards the society. A project named KALPTARUH was initiated by Bramhakumaris, a spiritual organization collaborating with students to extend their services to the environment. This project aims to incorporate five important values Shanti, Prema, Sahanaseelatha, Karunaand Namratha. She described about each of these values. She beautifully explained the struggles of a plant in becoming a tree. Like, it cannot run away despite storm, wind and insects, it shows how to stay strong and humble.

She continued the explanation regarding the importance of Meditation in one's life forgetting progress. She described Meditation as connection with self, with supreme energy and with nature. She also explained about the vibrations one would get, while meditating and howit helps to make a change in lives. She made the students meditate for 3 minutes and made them realize the power of meditation.

Followed by this, MrV.K.Vinay spoke on Kalptaruh project. He also said that the quality of life is falling drastically and growing plants could be the best solution. Every one made a pledge to extend their services to the society. Then Mr V. K. Revanth detailed and tutored

about Kalp-Taruha. Later, a rally was conducted in the college surroundings to voice the importance of plantation, every one planted the saplings in and around the college premises.



Each of them adopted a plant and owed to take care of it, by writing their favourite value on the tags, which were being tied to the saplings. All of them watered the plants and took an oath to water them daily. ## **Activity-I: House to house awareness on post covid complications and demonstration of CPR and other emergency procedures**

### **Objectives:**

- To deal with post covid complications.
- To extract preparedness during emergency.
- To perform first aid measures in those conditions.

**Methodology:** Our volunteers were trained to perform CPR and emergency procedures by B Pharm and Pharm D students. They practiced these procedures until they reach the perfection. We divided them in to groups. They visited each house of the village and demonstrated CPR and emergency procedures. The villagers were also practiced to perform these procedures.

**Impact:**Cardiac arrest is the one of the serious post Covid implications. The lack of knowledge and preparedness towards it was significantly increasing mortality rate. Family members are the first responders for such emergency situations and hence training and preparing them to handle the emergency is a significant need. 350 families of Mundlapudi were trained about CPR and emergency procedures there by the number of people qualified to deal with someone who was suffering with cardiac arrest was increased.




